Dear Parents/Guardians

Our Executive Team and P&C Association of Brisbane South State Secondary College are now able to provide you with the details of our Student Resource Scheme (SRS) for 2025.

The attached booklet includes important information about the fees and inclusions of the SRS, how the scheme operates, and the annual participation fee.

The scheme ensures that students have the resources required for them to engage with the curriculum for their education, and saves parents time and money in sourcing the prescribed materials elsewhere. Savings are gained through the school's bulk purchasing practices and hiring arrangements. The scheme is not used to raise funds for other purposes, and revenue collected through the scheme is applied only to the resources and operation of the scheme.

The scheme's operation, resource inclusions, and participation fees were approved by the school's P&C Association. The Year 7 to 10 SRS was endorsed on 14 October 2024 and the Year 11 SRS on 18 November 2024.

[ICT Guarantee of Service](#)

In order to support our high standard of ICT deliverance within the College, we have implemented a BYOD ICT Guarantee of Service. This fee better equips the College to meet the ever-increasing needs of ICT within our digital literacy model, the issues students may face in their day-to-day operations with their computer, and provide expert advice if an issue arises so that you, as the parent and student, are informed when needing to seek warranty or out of warranty repairs on your child's device.

This ICT Guarantee of Service and BYOD program fee will be invoiced to all student in early March 2025.

Locker Hire

All students have been allocated a locker and are required to return a signed 2025 Locker Hire Agreement Form (attached). All students will be invoiced for Locker Hire.

UQ Sport Levy

As part of our unique design and our collaboration with UQ, we access UQ's world-class sporting fields at a discounted rate to provide all sporting opportunities to our students. The UQ sport fee covers various sporting activities, including intra and inter sporting programs, that is not covered in our Memorandum of Understanding but exclusively available to BSSSC. The UQ Sports Levy information and invoicing will be provided to all families early March 2025.

Year 9 to 11 Electives

- ✓ All electives and subject levies will incur a fee that is not covered by the SRS.
- ✓ Year 9 to 10 students will be invoiced for Semester 1 Electives in March 2025
- ✓ Year 9 to 10 students will be invoiced for Semester 2 Electives in July 2025
- ✓ Semester 2 Electives (Years 9 to 10) will be invoiced early in Semester 2.

International Bacculaureate Program

If your student is part of our IB Program (Diploma or Career Pathway), you will be receiving a letter and invoice shortly, which will provide information regarding the fee structure and the Pathway Equity program to support this opportunity.

Payment Arrangement

Several payment options including a single payment for the full year's fee or term instalments are available. An instalment plan can also be negotiated with the college.

Any unpaid invoices, will be managed according to the Department's Debt Management Procedure, and may result in the student being excluded from the scheme and/or from participating in non-curricular activities until payment is made (<https://ppr.qed.qld.gov.au/pp/debt-management-procedure>).

Our college runs a cashless system. Payments can be made by BPOINT, Qkr! and Centrepay.

We additionally charge User Pays Subject Fees (UPSF) to cover direct costs of activities, external courses, excursions and consumables.

Please complete the SRS Participation Agreement Form and SRS Fee Payment Arrangement Form to formalise your participation in the scheme and to advise of your payment intentions. Should you be experiencing financial difficulties, please contact the Business Manager to discuss your payment options.

Student Resource Scheme Information

This fee schedule includes important information about the fees and inclusions for the SRS and user pay schemes. If you have previously opted in to the SRS your participation is assumed for the remainder of your child's enrolment, unless you inform the school otherwise by completing a new participation agreement form. If you are a new parent to the school, this information will assist you in making a decision as to whether you wish to participate in the SRS.

What is provided by the Queensland Government?

The Queensland Government supports children's education by providing funding for instruction (teachers), facilities (school grounds and buildings, internet), and administration (staff to run the school). Funding for schools does not extend to individual student resources such as textbooks, equipment for personal use, and many items used by the student in the classroom.

The SRS helps parents to source these resources. The school can purchase resources at lower rates due to its bulk buying power. Resources such as textbooks or musical instruments that will be used over a period of time are hired to students to further reduce costs for families. Participating in the SRS also offers a convenient way for parents to source the items that their child needs for school, and ensures that all students have access to the same standard of resources.

The types of resources that will be included are:

- Owned by the student – e.g. student diary – once provided, these items are retained by the student and used at their discretion.
- Hired to the student for a specific duration of time – e.g. textbooks or musical instruments – these items will need to be returned to the school in reasonable condition at the end of the hire period or if the student leaves the school.
- Used in class – e.g. stationery, timber, material, workbooks – these items will be used in class. Finished products that are created from these resources will generally come home with the student.

The Fee

Brisbane South State Secondary College Student Resource Scheme has been endorsed by the P&C and is a combination of flat and subject fees.

If you are not satisfied that the SRS fee represents good value for money based on the inclusions (over the page), you may choose not to participate in the SRS. If that is the case, please complete a new Participation Agreement Form, indicating that you no longer wish to participate. If you choose not to participate, you will be provided with a detailed list of resources that you will need to provide for the student.

The TRA

The Department of Education provides a Textbook and Resource Allowance (TRA) to assist parents with the cost of textbooks and other education resources for eligible Years 7 to 12 students. The Government Textbook and Resource Allowance is paid directly to the school for eligible students. Certain students are not entitled to the (TRA), namely Exchange Students, Full Fee-Paying Students, Adult Students (aged 18 years and older) and Students from other states enrolling after the cut-off date (the first Friday in August). The Department encourages schools to provide Student Resource Schemes to minimise costs for parents. Please see the back of the Participation Agreement Form for eligibility.

For those students who are eligible to receive the TRA, the TRA will be applied to reduce the cost of participation specific to your child's year level, please see the appropriate year level section below. The SRS invoice you receive will be the full cost of participation in the SRS minus the TRA already held at the school.

Please be aware that there may be two lines of charges on your invoice indicating the GST inclusive and GST exclusive fees depending on the resources supplied by the SRS.

Financial Difficulty

If you would like to participate, but are experiencing financial difficulties, please contact the school to arrange an appointment to discuss options. Any information that you provide will be confidential.

Resources will not be distributed until the full or first payment has been paid to the school. Any unpaid invoices, will be managed according to the department's Debt Management Procedure and may result in the student being excluded from the scheme and/or from participating in extra-curricular activities until payments are made.

A repair or replacement cost will be charged to the parent for any items that are damaged or not returned.

SRS Terms and Conditions

Definition

1. Reference to a "parent" is in accordance with the definition in the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006 and refers equally to an independent student.

Purpose of the SRS

2. In accordance with the Act, the cost of providing instruction, administration and facilities for the education of students enrolled at state schools who are Australian citizens or permanent residents, or children of Australian citizens or permanent residents, is met by the State.
3. Parents are directly responsible for providing textbooks and other personal resources for their children while attending school.
4. The SRS enables a parent to enter into an agreement with the school to provide the resources as advised by the school for a specified annual participation fee.

Participation in the SRS

5. Participation in the SRS is optional and parents are under no obligation to participate.
6. The school will provide parents with a list of resources supplied by the SRS to enable parents to assess the cost effectiveness of participation.
7. Parents indicate whether or not they wish to participate in the SRS by completing this Participation Agreement Form.
8. Parents must complete and sign the Participation Agreement Form and return it to the school by the advertised date.
9. This agreement is for the duration of the student's enrolment at the school, unless a new Participation Agreement Form is completed.
10. Parents are given the option annually to choose whether to participate in the SRS or not by completing this form.
11. Where a parent signs up to participate in the SRS they are agreeing to pay the annual participation fee for the items provided by the SRS.
12. Payment of the participation fee implies acceptance of the SRS including the Terms and Conditions irrespective of whether or not the signed form has been returned.
13. Where a student starts at the school during the school year, the parent may be entitled to pay a pro-rata participation fee to participate based on a 40 week school year.
14. Where a participation fee has been paid and a student leaves the school during the year, the school must determine if the parent is eligible for a pro-rata refund. This will also take into account any prorate of the Textbook and Resource Allowance (TRA) (see Additional Information regarding TRA eligibility) and any outstanding SRS debts (including any debts from damaged or non-returned items). Where the cost of outstanding debts is higher than the calculated refund, the parent is liable to pay this balance of funds.

Non-Participation in the SRS

15. Parents who choose not to participate in the SRS are responsible for providing their student with all items that would otherwise be provided by the SRS to enable their student to engage with the curriculum.
16. The school will provide non-participating parents with a list of resources the parents are required to supply for their child.
17. All items included in the SRS must be able to be independently sourced, purchased and supplied by parents who choose not to participate in the SRS.
18. As the SRS operates for the benefit of participating parents and is funded from participation fees, SRS resources will not be issued to students whose parents choose not to participate in the SRS.

The Resources

19. SRS funds received by the school will only be expended on student resources outlined in the school's SRS and will not be expended on other items or used to raise funds for other purposes.
20. In return for payment of the participation fee, the SRS will provide the participating student with the entire package of resources for the specified participation fee. It is not available in parts unless specifically provided for by the school in the fee structure.



Student Resource Scheme

Terms and Conditions

21. The resources, as determined and advised by the school may be:

- retained by the student and used at their discretion; or
- used/consumed by the student in the classroom; or
- hired to the student for their personal use for a specified period of time.

22. All SRS resources hired to a student for their temporary use remain the property of the school. The resources must be returned by the agreed date or if the student leaves the school.

23. Parents are responsible for ensuring that any hired SRS resources provided for their child's temporary use are kept in good condition.

24. The school administration office must be notified immediately of the loss or damage to any hired item.

25. Where a hired item is lost, not returned, or damaged, parents will be responsible for payment to the school of the value of the item or its repair.

26. The replacement cost of any resource may be up to the maximum value (subject to depreciation where appropriate) of the acquisition cost to the school.

27. Parents may be responsible for supplying their child with other resources not specified in the SRS as advised by the school.

Payment Arrangements

28. Payment of the participation fee may be made in whole, as per a nominated payment plan, or for another amount as approved by a Principal.

29. Payment of the participation fee must be made as per the payment methods nominated by the school.

30. Any concessions relating to the participation fee will be at the discretion of the Principal.

Debt Management

31. Payment of the participation fee is a requirement for continued participation in the SRS.

32. Non-payment of the participation fee by designated payment date(s) may result in debt recovery action in accordance with the Department's Debt Management Procedure [http://ppr.qed.qld.gov.au/corp/finance/accounts/Pages/](http://ppr.qed.qld.gov.au/corp/finance/accounts/Pages/Debt-Management.aspx)

Parents' Experiencing Financial Hardship

33. Parents experiencing financial hardship who are currently participating in or wish to participate in the SRS should contact the school to discuss options.

34. Principals may vary payment options, negotiate alternative arrangements and/or waive all or part of the participation fee for parents experiencing financial hardship.

35. The onus of proof of financial hardship is on the parent.

36. The school may require annual proof of continuing financial hardship.

37. All discussions will be held in the strictest confidence.

Additional Information

Textbook and Resource Allowance (TRA)

- The Queensland Government provides financial assistance to parents of students in Years 7 to 12, to offset the costs of textbooks and other resources. Assistance is provided in the form of a TRA which is paid through the school. Refer to the department's website for current TRA rates <https://education.qld.gov.au/about-us/budgets-funding-grants/grants/parents-and-students/textbook-resource-allowance>;
- The TRA is used to offset the fees associated with participation in the SRS;
- Parents not participating in the SRS will receive the TRA directly from the school;
- Parents not participating in the SRS should contact the school directly if they do not automatically receive the payment.

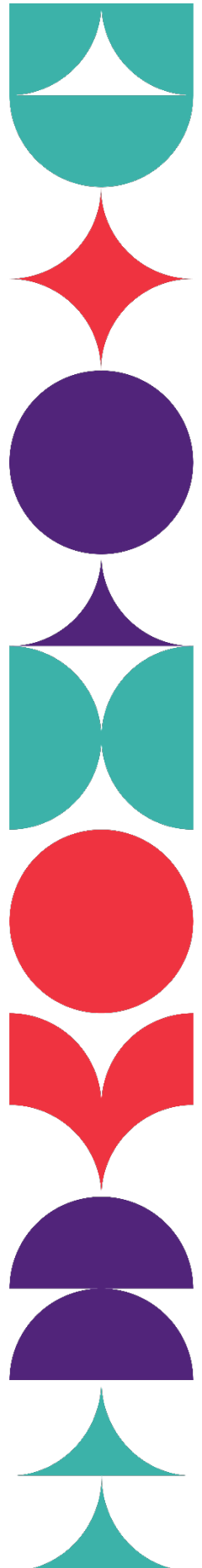

Locker Hire Agreement 2025

As per our Locker Policy, all students are required to be allocated a locker each year. The annual hire fee for 2025 will be \$25.00 per locker. An invoice for \$25.00 will be generated as soon as we are in receipt of this signed Agreement. Once we receive payment of the locker invoice, we will issue a locker to your student.

Terms of Agreement for Locker Hire 2025

Agreement

- It is the responsibility of the student not to disclose the lock combination to others.
- Students are not allowed to move from one locker to another unless authorised by staff.
- No leftover food is to remain in the locker.
- Valuables should not be left in the lockers and if left, are at the student's own risk.
- Students are not permitted to store any dangerous chemicals or drugs inside the lockers.
- Students are required to pay the annual hire fee in full before locks and lockers can be issued.
- Students are only allowed to use school allocated locks on lockers.
- Students are required at the end of the school year to return allocated locks to the administration office and ensure that the lockers are free of any items and rubbish. If a student fails to return a lock they will be invoiced for a replacement at \$12.50 per lock. If a student does not leave the locker free of items and rubbish they will be invoiced a removal and cleaning fee of \$10.00.
