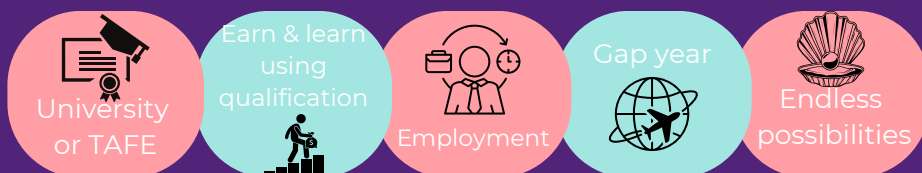

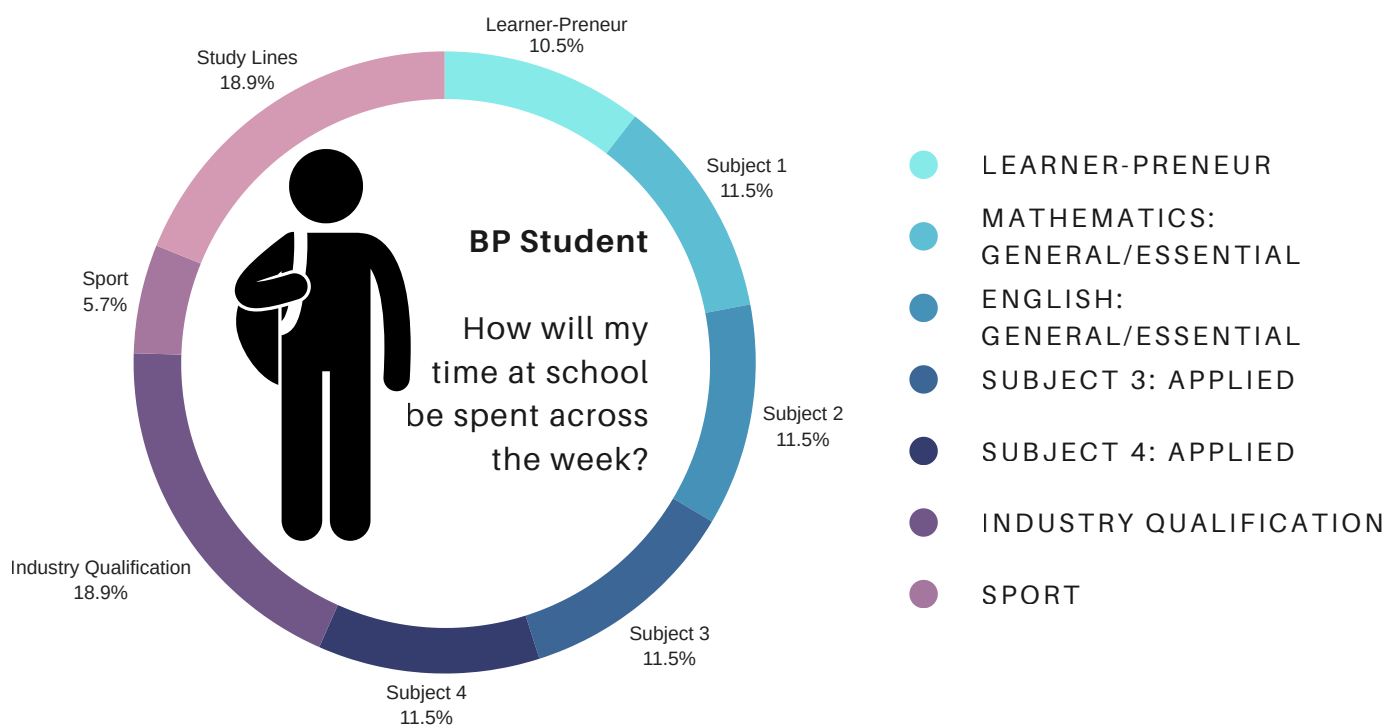

Your Commitment to Growth & Success

Attendance = achievement. Research informed data states that high attendance is one of the precursors for high achievement.

Academia = habits and routines. Good learners have developed or working hard on developing time management, organisational skills, meeting all deadlines, asking good questions and seeking feedback and being active learners in class to have agency and success in their courses. This is often measured through effort and behaviour.

PRE-REQUISITES

For students to select this pathway due to the hybrid nature and variation to school routine, students must have:

- 90% attendance or higher in Year 10,
- Achieve C's or higher in Year 10 subjects chosen to align with Blended Pathway
- Students wishing to select any General subjects, need to meet the B grade pre-requisite and understand that off campus time will affect some lessons
- Receive good effort and behaviour
- Be demonstrating and committing to good learning habits, eg. meeting all deadlines
