- Ensure percentage of students reaching 99% attendance and accessing enrichment activities.

- Implement collaborative data inquiry processes (to build teachers' ability to interpret data, identify and scale-up effective teaching practices and differentiate effectively).
- Implement key improvement strategies and 'Deep Learning Reasoning' in numeracy with the 'The Learner First Numeracy' project coach.

- Implementation of pedagogical and instructional frameworks including embedding the culture, climate, processes and protocls of classroom observation and feedback to support professional development and encourage reflective practice/action learning.
